The 2nd Annual *Homestead Show & Market* will take place on June 9th and 10th, 2017 at Midnight Stadium in Fort Macleod. Farms, businesses and hobbyists selling and promoting:

- Heritage and exotic breeds of livestock and poultry, sustainable/homesteading-type products, green energy, and "field-to-table" products are encouraged to register for a booth. This market will also provide a venue for other individuals wishing to sell baked goods, wood-working, jewelry, deli, other artistic creations, and promote their home-based business.

NEW for 2017! – all vendors, including livestock/poultry vendors will be selling over **BOTH days of the sale.** Last year, livestock/poultry vendors only operated on the Saturday. There will be demonstrations and presentations given by a variety of speakers again over the two days as well.

BOOTH DESCRIPTION

- Dimensions are 15' x 10'.
- **Cost per booth:**
 - **Non-commercial** -- \$40/day (two days); \$50/day (1 day only)
 - **Commercial** – \$100/day (two days); \$120/day (1 day only).
- Multiple vendors are welcome to share a booth and split the cost if so desired.
- Vendors are responsible for all items (i.e. tables, power cords, display cases, etc.) needed in the booth.
 - Panels and temporary corrals for larger livestock (i.e. sheep) are available for an additional cost.
 - Horse stalls are also available for an additional cost or in place of a booth.
 - Feed and bedding (shavings) for livestock is the responsibility of the vendors. There is water available on site. Shavings and feed will be available onsite for purchase courtesy of Friesen Farm Store.
 - Please see livestock sale rules document, included in the package
- **Power is available for some booths; priority is given to pre-paid booths.**

REGISTRATION

- All booths must be paid for and registered by **June 1, 2017.**
- Once payment has been received, confirmation will be sent to you via email. A receipt (if desired) will be given when checking in at the event.

SET UP AND TAKE DOWN

- All booths (including livestock/poultry) can be set up on the morning of June 9th between the hours of 8:00 am and 12:30 pm.
 - If you require additional time arrangements can be made with Lee or Geraldine.
- On the second day (Saturday) vendors will be able to prepare their booths and tend to livestock between the hours of 7:00 and 9:00 am.
- Once the Homestead Market has come to a close on June 10th, vendors are expected to dismantle their booths. Receptacles will be provided for garbage.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

SECURITY

- The stadium will be locked outside of Homestead Show & Market operating hours and setup times.
- Booths can remain setup over the Friday night; it is recommended that vendors cover their items with a sheet.
- There will be staff staying onsite and doing checks to reduce the risk of any potential security issues.

CONSIGNMENT/REVERSE AUCTION

- All vendors are asked to consign an item from their booth for the Reverse Auction being held on the second day of the Homestead Show & Market, June 10th.
- Vendors are still entitled to the sale proceeds of the consignment proceeds, less consignment fee (please see "Consignment/Reverse Auction" document).
- **Why? The Reverse Auction is a fun, family event aimed at extending the visitor's length of time at the Homestead Show & Market, translating to more overall success for our vendors.**
- Examples of consignments could include: 1 dozen hatching eggs, 1 pair of heritage breed chickens, baked items, homemade serving platter, etc.

BREAKFAST

- Breakfast, courtesy of Stockman's Grill, will be available to vendors on the morning of June 10th. Make sure you check the box on the registration form if you would like breakfast.

ACCOMODATION

- Vendors are welcome to camp over night at the stadium in the approved area.
 - Cost is \$15 per unit; no services
- **Fort Macleod has a number of accommodation options.**
